



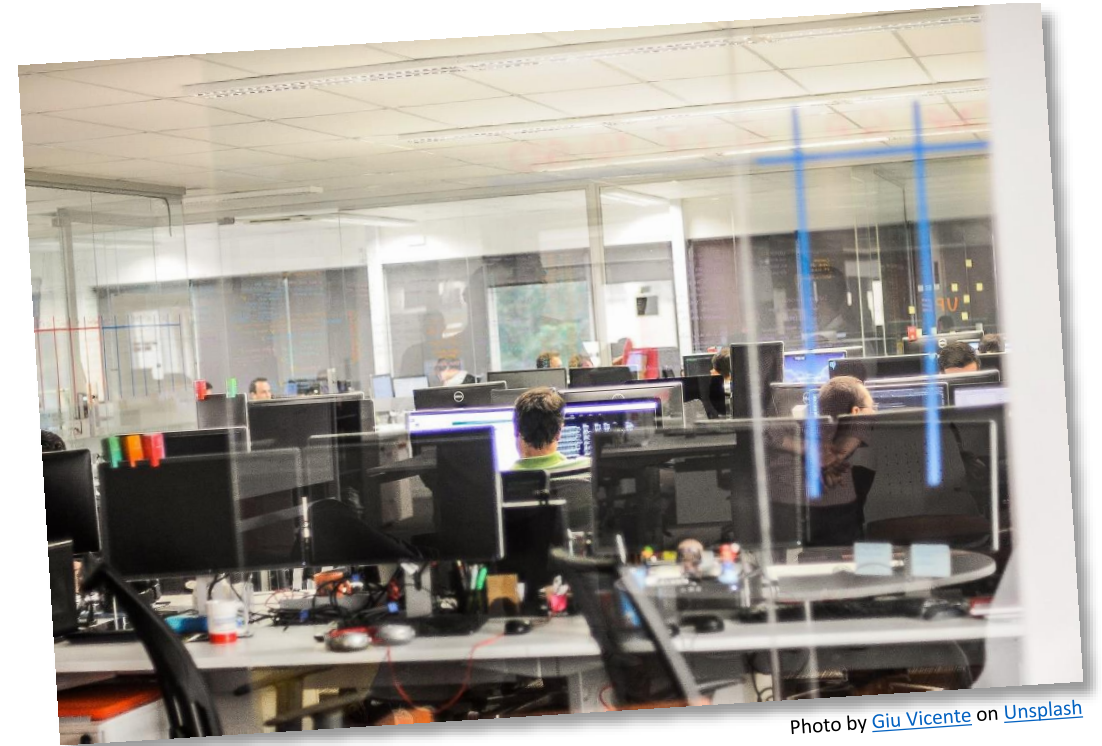

Benefits for Publishers

- theIPRegistry.org already contains over 1.5 billion verified IP addresses
- All new IPs will be fully vetted and verified before dissemination to publishers
- IP changes can be pushed out to publisher systems automatically via API - this prevents the introduction of errors due to manual entry
- Integration of theIPRegistry.org into publisher systems will save staff time and costs



Benefits for Libraries


- Libraries can check the IPs that publishers use to provide access and attribute usage – the data in the registry was supplied by over 150 publishers so provides a valuable snapshot of how access is provided
- Dissemination of IP updates to multiple publishers at the click of a button
- Integration of theIPregistry.org into library work flows will save staff time and costs

When an organisation clicks on the “sign up here” link, the IP address they are accessing the site from will be recognised. If the correct organisation is recognised they should click the “Yes, continue and register” button.

IP addresses may not be correctly recognised if users are accessing the Registry via mobile devices or from an off-site location.

If this is the case they should click the “No, let me search for a different organisation” button.

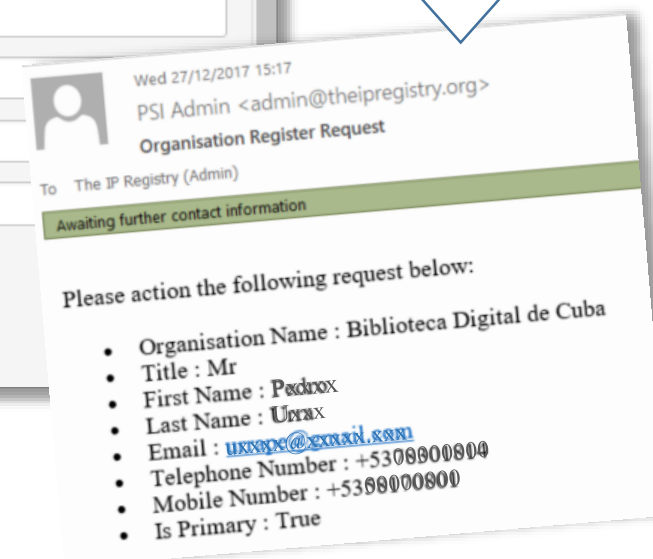

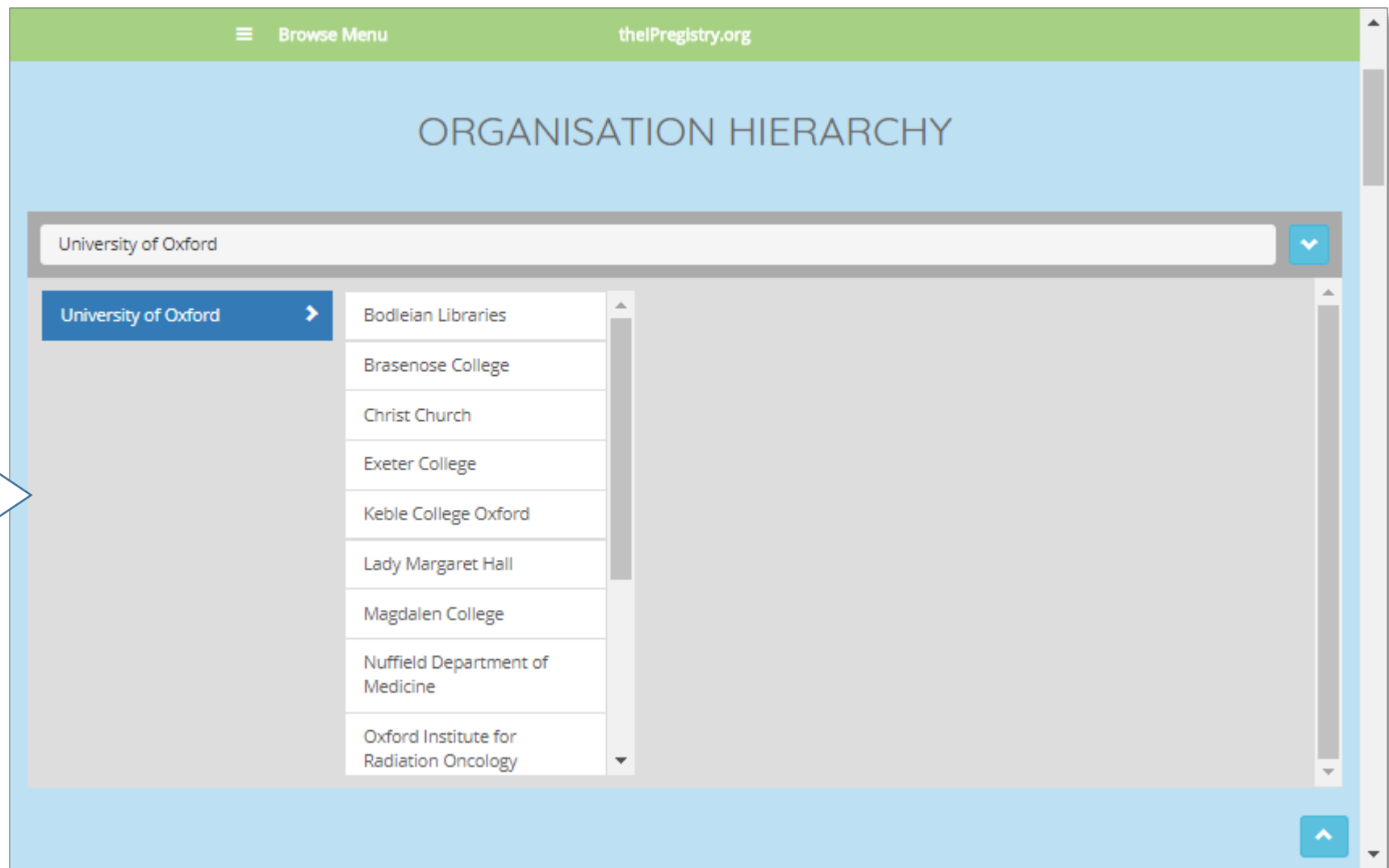

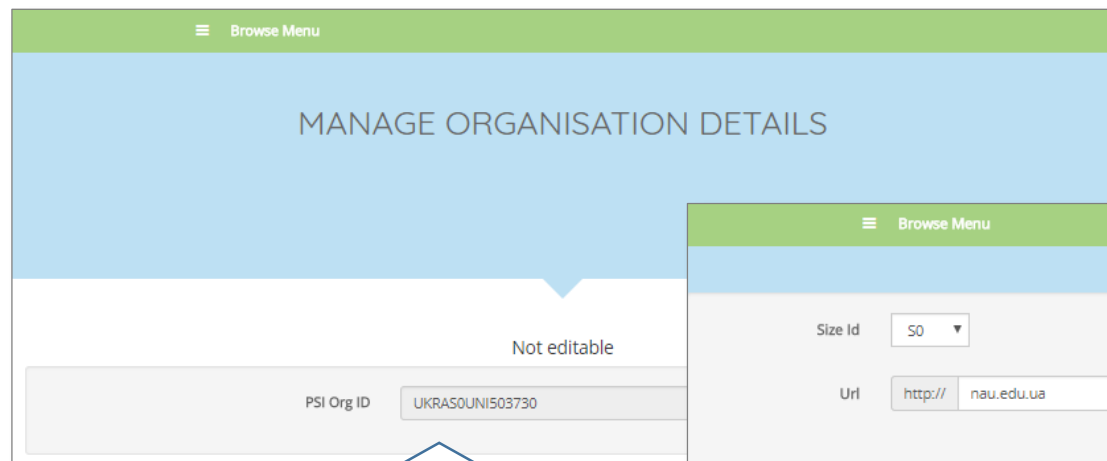

Customer users can request to be set up as the administrator for any of their child organisations by contacting the IP registry team.





Some details cannot be edited, e.g. PSI Org ID, Size Name, Children Inherit IPs check box.

Any details in the “Editable” section can be changed immediately.

The IP Registry team may require supporting evidence and/or corroboration from other sources before making changes to the information in this section.

Any details in the “Approval Required” section can be edited, but changes will be submitted to the IP Registry for approval.

Customer users can edit their organisation’s details by clicking on the “Manage Organisation Details” button.

Customer users can edit their organisation's IP addresses by clicking on the "Manage IP Address Details" button.

Before saving any changes customer users will be asked to submit "supporting documentation".

Customer users can add IPs, delete IPs or change the status of an IP.

We accept the following forms of supporting documentation:

1. Copy of email detailing the change
2. Free text explanation to support the change (e.g. "I, Joe Bloggs, administrator for XYZ University, confirm that this is an old IP and no longer used. JoeBloggs@xyzuni.edu 5.1.2018").

IP changes are also double checked against IANA data. If, for example, the customer's IP address relates to the wrong country this will be flagged and the publisher will be advised. The publisher will also be advised if the IP address relates to a hospital etc., so that licenses can be checked and amended if necessary.

If an IP address is already recognised within the registry a warning message will appear. This will eliminate a large number of potential errors.

IPs listed in green are verified, those listed in amber are awaiting verification, and purples are third party aggregators such as EZ Proxy.

All IP changes will be vetted for:

- Correct country – this information is checked against IANA as well as the Registry itself
- Correct institution – only verified users are able to make changes for their institution. To be verified, users must access via an appropriate institutional email address or provide proof of their affiliation with the institution
- Supporting documentation and/or corroboration is required when creating associations between organisations
- Access to the Registry is by IP address validation and Username and Password to ensure it is secure
- If affiliations, foreign campuses or additional research sites for corporates are set up, an email notification will be sent to the publisher so adjustments to licenses can be made if necessary

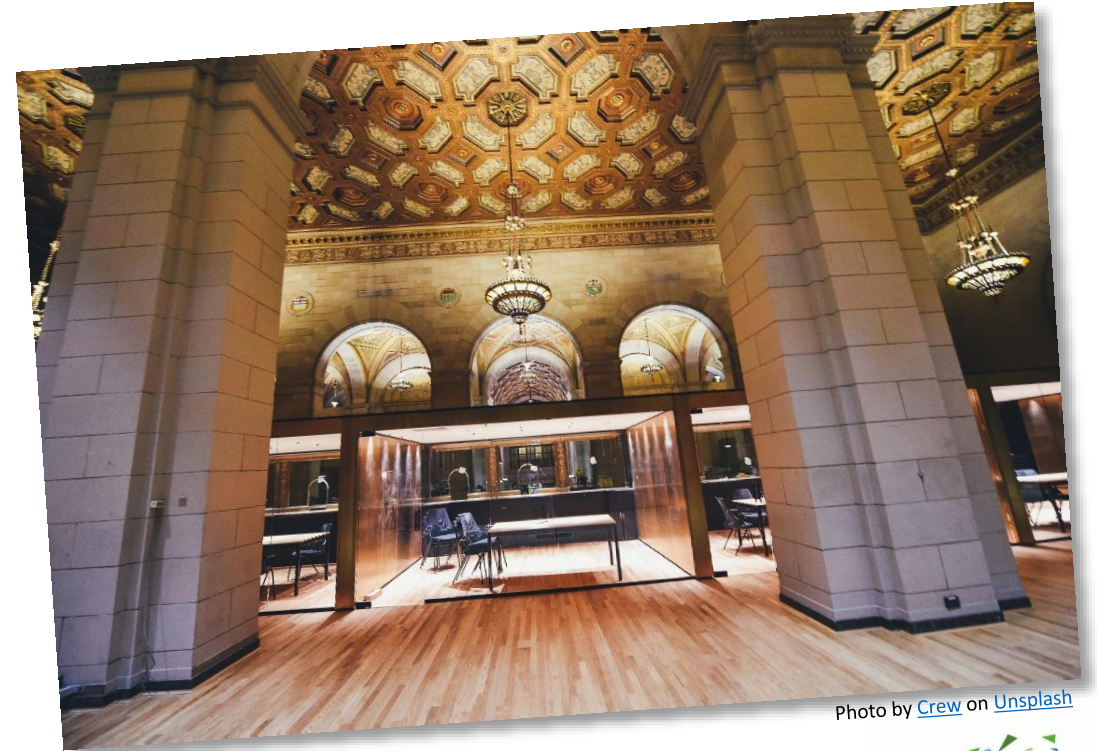
